Health Officials Launch Community Survey to Improve Services for the Navajo People

WINDOW ROCK, Ariz. – The Navajo Department of Health (NDOH) has launched a community-wide survey to gather input from Navajo citizens and community members to help strengthen and improve health services across the Nation.

The survey invites feedback on NDOH's 14 programs and divisions and is designed to better understand community needs, identify service gaps, and guide future improvements.

“Navajo voices are essential to shaping effective and culturally grounded health services,” **said NDOH Executive Director Sherylene Yazzie.** “This survey allows our communities to directly inform NDOH and President Nygren how we improve access, quality, and care for our people.”

All responses are confidential and will be used solely to address concerns, ideas, and recommendations shared by participants. Community members are encouraged to share their perspectives to support the ongoing effort to protect and promote the well-being of Navajo families.
